Prof. Minu Bajpai is Head of Department of Paediatric Surgery at All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi (AIIMS, New Delhi). After his MCh in Paediatric Surgery he has completed his PhD in Paediatric Surgery; he is FRCS (Glasgow), FACS (USA), FAMS, Diplomate of National Board and ECFMG certified. He has been a Fulbright scholar (John Hopkins, Baltimore), Commonwealth fellow (GOS, London) and a Raja Ramanna Fellow (Science & Technology). He has been felicitated with the prestigious Kamla Menon Award in Pediatrics (1995), Kunti Om Prakash Medal (2008), MSR Oration Medal (2012), Kolkata Oration Medal (2014) and the Government of Afghanistan Medal.

Prof. Bajpai is currently heading the National Board of Examination in Medical Sciences in multiple capacities including Vice-President, Honorary Executive Director and Member of the Governing Council. At the apex of one of the largest bodies in the country governing one of the largest medical curriculum (DNB), he is in a very responsible position and equipped with armamentarium to expedite the development of the Paediatric Surgery specialty and community both manifold. Prof. Bajpai is also the convener of the MCI Committee on MCh curriculum.

Prof. Bajpai has served as the president of IAPS from 2014-15 and founded the Indian and Asian Societies of Paediatric Urology. He has been the member Committee on Transgenders Issues constituted by Ministry of Social Justice for developing basic infrastructure and health care facility for Transgenders in India. He has been the Chairman of several committees including the committees to start intensive care DM – Specialty course at AIIMS, MCh in TRAUMA at AIIMS, Hospital Store Purchase Committee for specific items, AIIMS committee for formulating guidelines for A.P.A.R., AIIMS committee for formulating guidelines for participating institutions for CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.

Academically, Prof. Bajpai has been on the forefront for decades now; he has contributed immensely to the current shape of Paediatric Surgery and Paediatric Urology in the country and internationally. He has authored more than 300 papers and more than 100 abstracts/ book chapters. He introduced the Progress in Paediatric Urology which has been the pioneer of developments in the field for the past several decades. He is the Executive Editor of Journals of Progress in Paediatric Surgery and Progress in Paediatric Surgery. He is the Principal Investigator for the Centre for Advanced Research in Congenital Uropathies and the Chief coordinator for the National Programme on Disorders of Sex Development (DSD) in India.

Prof. Bajpai designed the AIIMS muscle stimulator used in the surgery of Bladder Exstrophy & Anorectal Malformations. (National Research Development Corporation Registration No. PATENT/4.13.7/96088/96). The Patent is available as a low cost product named AIIMS muscle stimulator is currently in use widely by most Paediatric surgeons in the country.
